



Basic Incident Investigation Training Course

The purpose of the forestry Basic Incident Investigation Course is to provide a level of knowledge about the incident investigation processes that are required to lead an incident investigation that identifies Root Causes and drives effective Corrective or Preventative Actions.

This one day course will provide supervisors, safety coordinators and others working within the forest industry with a basic understanding of the methods and tools employed in order to conduct effective basic incident investigations. This training offers useful and practical tools required to begin the development of a complete incident investigation program for forestry employers.

IMPORTANT: The Basic Incident Investigation Course does not go into the detail required to allow students to lead complex investigations with serious potential consequences such as legal liability.
